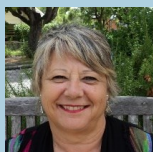
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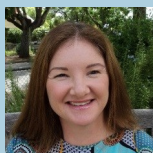

South Australia's History Festival

The History Festival is on from the **28th April to 31st May**, run by the History Trust of SA. You can find out more information about the month long event at <https://historyfestival.sa.gov.au/>. There are events in the city or locally at Mitcham and Brownhill Creek to discover some local history.

Delving into history is a great way for children to develop wonder, curiosity and respect about cultures, people and places in the world they live in, both past and present.

History is taught at school with additional aims of ensuring students develop:

- enjoyment of the study of historical phenomena
- key historical knowledge of people, places, values and systems, past and present, in local to global contexts
- an understanding and appreciation of historical developments that shape society, influence sustainability and create a sense of belonging
- the ability to use inquiry methods, including questioning, researching, analysing, evaluating and communicating
- dispositions required for effective participation in everyday life, now and in the future.

People love studying history for various reasons. They have the opportunity to learn how societies functioned, including how governments were developed, and about cultures of countries they may be unable to explore in person. Given we can't time travel; history is a window to the past. We 'research' through a variety of sources: artefacts, people, books, websites, photographs etc. to build understanding of past eras. We can also use the opportunity to learn from the mistakes of others.

History in primary years of school begins with learning about personal and family histories, past and present family and local community, to Australian history. The SA History Festival will be an opportunity to learn some local history with your children.

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NAPLAN On-line

From 15th May to 25th May, our Year 3, 5 and 7 students will be sitting the National Assessment Program for Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) tests.

Students have had the opportunity last term to take part in some preliminary orientation to understand the platform of the online tests, and we are confident that they will perform to their ability on the days.

NAPLAN provides a snapshot of your child's progress in Literacy and Numeracy. It is just another way of finding out what students are able to do or not yet able to do. Therefore, it is important to encourage your child to be involved and participate in the testing, as this information enables us to support and extend students with tailored programs.

Some nervousness is to be expected, but you as parents/caregivers can assist your child by treating NAPLAN test days as any other school day.

Students who are absent from school on the day of the test, will be required to complete a catch-up test later in the week.

All information regarding the completion of the ED176 form is included in the handbook and we encourage all parents/caregivers to make themselves familiar with the contents of the handbook and jointly agree on where their child will apply to attend secondary school.

The ED176 form must be returned by **Friday 25th May 2018**.

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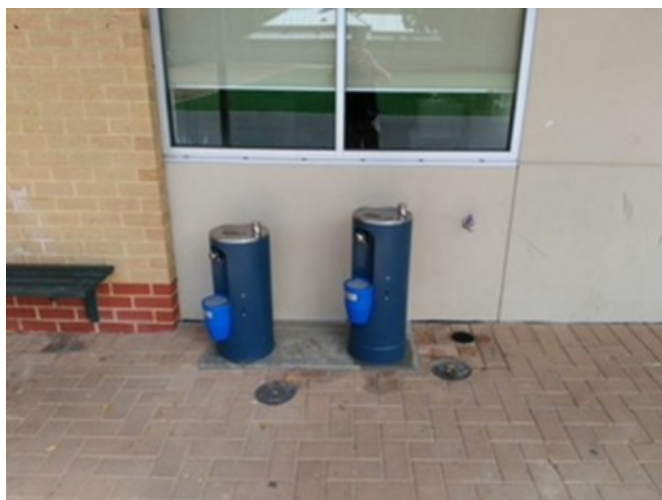
